Membership: As of 31 January, Idaho has 7 Posts that are 100% or greater in membership (at this point last year, we had 15) and 2 Districts are at 90% or above (at this point last year, we had 5). The Department is 831 members away from reaching 100% and stands 41st out of 52 Departments at 88.16%. At this point last year, the department was at 94%, #27 in the Nation and 395 members short of 100%. We, as a Department are way behind last year's numbers and I have faith that we can pull this out with everyone's help. Again, look at your
